Revision unit: Build up to Gateway B1

- Vocabulary: Appearance and personality, describing yourself and other people, rooms and furniture, school subjects.
- Grammar: verb "to be", "have got", personal pronouns (subject, object), possessives ('s genitive, possessive adjective, possessive pronoun), demonstratives, there is/are, plurals, present simple), frequency adverbs.

Gateway B1: Units 1 and 2

- Vocabulary: Ages and stages of life, the family, noun suffixes –ment, -ion, -ence, crimes, criminals, phrasal verbs connected with investigating and finding.
- Grammar: Present simple, present continuous, state and action verbs, articles, Past simple, Past continuous.
- Civilization: Teenager and parents, the British secret Intelligence service.
- Click onto art: Graffiti
- Click onto history: The origin of the British Police

Gateway B1: Units 3 and 4

- Vocabulary: countries, nationalities and languages, learning a language, negative prefixes: un-, in-, im-, ir-, il-, parts of the body, health problems and illnesses, compound nouns connected with health and medicine.
- Grammar: Some, any, much, many, a lot of, a few, a little, relative pronouns, Present perfect simple and continuous, Present perfect with for, since, just, yet already, Present perfect vs Past simple.
- Civilization: English as an international language

Gateway B1: Units 5 and 6

- Vocabulary: TV programmes, adjectives describing TV programmes, adjectives ending in –ing and –ed, geographical features, the environment, different uses of get.
- Grammar: Comparatives and superlatives, less...than and (not) as....as, too and (not) enough, be going to, will, may, might, zero conditional and first conditional, first conditional and time clauses.

Gateway B1: Units 7 and 8

- Vocabulary: Jobs, personal qualities, compound adjectives, relationships, feelings, noun suffixes –ness, -ship, -dom.
- Grammar: Modal verbs of obligation, prohibition and advice, second conditional, Past perfect, Used to, Gerunds and infinitives, question tags.
