E' stato svolta tutta la parte di grammatica e lessico del libro propedeutico **Build up to Gateway B1** e sono state svolte non solo tutte le Unità prefissate nel piano di lavoro (Units 1-7), ma anche le Unità 8 e 10, e il lessico della Unit 9; le strutture grammaticali sono state approfondite ed esercitate anche nella grammatica.

Gli argomenti di **grammatica** trattati sono:

Present simple 'to be'; have got; subject pronouns; 's genitive; possessive adjectives; demonstratives; there is/there are; plurals; prepositions of place; yes/no questions and short answers; prepositions of time; Whose and possessive pronouns; frequency adverbs; can/can't; adverbs of manner; countables and uncountables; imperative; present simple and present continuous; state verbs; articles; past simple; past continuous; quantifiers (some, any, much, many, a lot of, a few, a little); relative pronouns (defining relative clauses); present perfect; present perfect continuous; present perfect and simple past; comparatives and superlatives; too, enough; forme di suggerimento: let's, shall we, why don't we, what about; future forms present continuous, to be going to, will, present simple); may/might; zero conditional; first conditional with if, unless, as soon as, after, until; modal verbs of obligation, prohibition, advice (must, have to, should); second conditional; past perfect; used to; gerunds and infinitives (some verbs and some patterns); question tags; the passive (all tenses).

Il **lessico** contestualmente trattato riguarda:

Alphabet; cardinal and ordinal numbers; months, dates, years; countries and nationalities; colours; physical appearance; family, school subjects; days of the week; everyday activities; free time activities; sports; ages and stages in life; the family: noun suffixes (-ment, -ion, -ence); crime and criminals; phrasal verbs connected with investigating and finding; countries, nationalities and languages; negative prefixes un-, in-, im-, ir-, il-; parts of the body; health problems and illnesses; adjectives in -ed/-ing; compound nouns connected with health and medicine; TV programmes; films; geographical features; the environment; different uses of 'get'; jobs; personal qualities; compound adjectives; relationships; feelings; noun suffixes: -ness, -ship, -dom; fiction, non-fiction; phrasal verbs connected with reading and writing; computers and computing; the internet; collocations with email.

Le **funzioni comunicative** trattate riguardano:

introducing people; asking and giving personal information; talking about ability; talking about likes and dislikes; telling the time; talking about routines; talking about the past; talking about future plans; making suggestions and arrangements; making predictions; describing and expressing feelings; asking for personal information; asking for information; finding out about childhood experiences; discussing reading habits; discussing computer use; talking about photos: speculation.
